MISSION: The mission of Life Resources is to serve adolescents and their families who are at risk of, or experiencing a crisis in their lives. Life Resources serves all families regardless of their race, religion or national origin, with acceptance, respect and dignity.

DESCRIPTION: The agency operates three residential programs, the Pilgrim Center for Boys located in Braintree, the Phaneuf Youth Center for boys located in Brockton, and the Bishop Ruocco for Girls, located in Lakeville. Each program offers adolescents a home away from home where they attend school, receive counseling services, and learn behavioral and daily living skills. The boys and girls in our programs come from cities and towns throughout the Archdiocese.

The youngsters served in these programs come from homes where they have experienced domestic violence, child abuse, neglect, substance abuse and exploitation. Many have had problems at home, in school, in the community, and in the State’s foster care system. Many have turned to crime and ended up in the Juvenile Justice System. Our programs make remarkable progress helping these “kids” turn their lives around. Life Resources is funded primarily through contracts with the state Department of Youth Services. The programs operate 24 hours a day, 365 days per year.
