Last night, at the request of Archbishop Sean O'Malley, Fr. Jack Ahern and Sr. Kathy O'Connor, CSB visited St. Albert's church in Weymouth as a first step towards opening lines of communication with the people of St. Albert's. For nearly three hours, Sr. Kathy and Fr. Jack listened and visited with the people there present. It was agreed that a meeting with the parish council would take place in the near future. Following last night's meeting, Archbishop Sean spoke with Sr. Kathy and received the concerns voiced by the people at St. Albert's. The Archbishop hopes and prays that this first encounter will lead to a mutually acceptable and peaceful resolution to this situation.
